Safety Assessment of Cosmetics an e-Training with a global Scope

CCE/RWTH International Academy's joint Cosmetic Product Safety Assessment e-Training goes into its 2nd season - **25 May 2021 marks the starting date for participation.**

"Now, I know how to do the core of the cosmetic product safety report; I am starting to feel as a Safety Assessor" - a participant's comment from the first season, which started in May 2020 (Article in Cosmetics Business on 22-Apr-2020).

Cosmetic Product Safety Assessment is a global imperative.
It requires knowledge in various science fields, technical and regulatory skills.

CCE recognized that the EU's cosmetics regulation provides a good assessment strategy, which multi-national CCE members can unify for worldwide approach. Best assessment results are achieved when safety assessors share their experiences; the learning curve of junior assessors increases considerably. Online-training allows easy participation, intense learning and active discussions; therefore, it maximizes personal goals.

Accordingly, the e-learning program was created. **It is hands-on, based on 6 training modules, each with 4 online-seminars and a full online-day for discussion. Fundamental science is taught by RWTH Aachen University staff and lecturers from CCE provide their assessment knowledge and practical experiences.** Scheduling is done in due time before a course; a full course is provided within a clear timeline of one year. Successful completion of a course allows performing a safety assessment.
